Dublin Dollars Board Meeting Minutes January 11, 2012

Chair report (Mary)

The See's Candy inventory is gone! Our next focus is the Big Band Swing Dance on January 28 and the Booster's Auction on February 11. The Big Band Swing Dance is not a Dublin Dollars event.

Mary is receiving many questions about where students stand money wise and also how students can get more hours. We are in need of more participatory events and ideas.

Hours report (Barb)

Barb reported that there are 2,594 hours recorded to date. The total divisible hours total 2,662. There are 107 students with over 12 hours. There are 48 parents that have reached their maximum contribution of 12 hours.

Discussion ensued to possibly compromise hours at 9 for people that signed up after 09/01. Discussion was tabled with no resolution. There was also a comment that we need more events to get hours, but we're not inventing events just for people to volunteer that will not reap a monetary benefit for the group.

Angelina Hughes commented that a focus needs to be on events where students can earn hours while making money for the group and suggested another See's Candy sale prior to Valentine's Day. Teri Gregg agreed to co-chair a See's Candy site sale the weekend before Valentine's Day, February 11 and 12, 2012.

Treasurer report (Peter)

To date \$39,444.32 has been raised.

Updates/Upcoming Events

- **Wigged Out Hair Cuts** (Fund A - Kendahl)
Kendahl reported that she has twenty spots total for people wishing to cut their hair for donations. She has five confirmed at this point leaving fifteen open spots. However, there are a total of seven people participating, one which has already donated her cut hair. The event is Friday, January 27 at 7:00 PM at James Alan Salon. The students collecting the donations will receive a 90% payout. The other 10% goes into the general fund. Kendahl will also have a bucket out for donations from anyone attending in support of our event.

Big Band Swing Dance (Barb & Nancy)

The BBSD is January 28. This is an ASB event where student volunteers can earn community service. This is **not** a Dublin Dollars event. However, Dublin Dollars will have a refreshment table and will need student and parent volunteers to staff the refreshment table. The event is taking place in the cafeteria. Volunteers are also needed to help during school hours making silhouettes etc.; contact Jil Scollard for additional volunteer duties. - **Boosters Auction** (Mary)

Mary reported that the Boosters are still needing auction items. The Dublin Dollars baskets are almost full and Mary will finish them with the additional cash donations that have been coming in. Other ideas that were presented for auction items included contacting Alec Wilmart for drum lessons and Mark McCartney for curling lessons.

Volunteers are also needed for Friday set up/clean up.

Proposals/Ideas for consideration/Items Needing Approval

- **Healthy Resolutions and Energy Solutions** (Mary for Sandra Jones)

Sandra Jones emailed Mary about a line of sports and nutrition/health products. This would be an online sale and/or orders can be placed through Sandra. 25% of the sales will be donated to Dublin Dollars.

Items include Spark Energy drink (mental focus), Slam Energy drink (weight loss), a meal replacement shake, and an herbal cleanse.

This fundraiser was approved by the board and Sandra Jones will follow up with googlegroup email.

- **Refreshment table at Tolo** (Mary for Linda Cobb)

The flag team is hosting tolo on February 10 at 7:00 PM. Linda Cobb was inquiring if we could have a refreshment table at tolo to benefit Dublin Dollars that would include treats, water and other beverages. The question was put to the Board of whether we want to put effort into this opportunity? Historically the turnout for this event has been low.

A vote was taken and the Board decided against participating.
