Treasurer's Report

- Almost \$14,000 raised so far. Make sure all checks are made payable to *Dublin Dollars*.

Updates

- **T-shirts** (Barb)
We have one corporate sponsor at \$500, Johnson's Auto Repair. We need a business liaison to approach businesses about this and other related issues. We need at least three more sponsors at \$500 to ensure one shirt is paid for, and preferably one \$2000 sponsor for the second shirt. We have a drop dead date of 9/14 at which point we will defray the cost of the shirts and pass it on to the students and parents by charging \$10 per shirt. *TO DO:* Mary will approach Planet Fitness and other businesses on Friday. *UPDATE:* Mary found one more sponsor, and is waiting to hear back from three more local businesses about sponsorships.
- **SC 50th Anniversary Open House** (Mary)
Props have been collected, and the photo booth is good to go. More adults volunteered to man the raffle and other areas which need support. This event is primarily adult run with some student support in distributing flyers throughout the school during the open house.
- **Raffle** (Denise)
Discussion of board members removing themselves from purchasing raffle tickets due to conflict of interest. Decision made that Mary, Peter and Denise Avgeres, and their spouses will not buy raffle tickets and will manage the tickets to ensure transparency.
- **Baker for a Day** (Louise and Jeana)
On track, almost all volunteer spots filled. The website www.volunteerspot.com is an amazingly easy and effective tool and should be used for other events. Mr. Caruso will not be at the event so we need to ensure a drum major is there to lead the band. Need to send an email to the Google group explaining the whole process, including forms to sell bread cards.
- **Rummage Sale** (Cheryl & Kendahl)
Sale is on track for 9/24 from 9-6pm. Cheryl to take care of big banner, items can be brought on Friday early evening (before the dance) for pricing and organizing. Will advertise in Shoreline News and a few days before on craigslist. Kendahl will provide change for two check outs. Hanna to provide additional clothing racks. We will also have a bake sale, raffle table, car wash tickets and jewelry table. The Drama department has requested being able to sell costumes at the same time, which was approved.

- **Practice Pals** (Nancy)

On track to send out flyers to elementary and middle schools for implementation in October and November, with potentially a second session in Feb.

Planning

Car Washes and candy sales have been good moneymakers and easy. They both seem like great opportunities to continue. Hope to sell See's Candy at ferry terminals again around Thanksgiving. Plan to have one weekend of candy selling per month at a high traffic grocery store through February.

Try to get one more car wash in in late September or early October, potentially at Whole Foods. Need to find someone willing to coordinate it.

Mary received approval to hold bake sales at Fall and Winter concerts. There are three concerts in October and three in December.

Barnes and Noble Gift Wrapping—Nancy Graves has contacted them.

Kendahl suggested that Dublin Dollars continue to fundraise over the next four years in preparation for the next group going on the Ireland trip. Will make it less intense during the year leading up to the trip. The key will be finding people willing to do the coordination of events and management of Dublin Dollars.
