## Dublin Dollars Board Meeting Minutes September 20, 2011

### **Chair report** (Mary)

We need to market our events more and get more participation. There was very little participation at the LF Bar & Grill event. We only made \$350 (although they gave us \$500 – a nice donation). We need to get more information out to the community for our fundraisers. We need to keep reminding DD families to help spread the word. It was brought up that chairs could market their events with the help of the liaisons that work through the district.

### **Treasurer report** (Peter)

So far \$18,502.76 has been raised. This includes the stock of candy not sold yet but will be sold. Future candy sales events are already on the books.

### **Hours report** (Barb)

1,721 total hours worked so far!! 64 students have over 12 hours. Discussed if some should step back so others with few hours could have a chance to get their 12 hours minimum. It's always been on a first come, first serve basis. Want to keep it that way.

### **Updates/Upcoming Events**

- **Practice Pals** (Nancy)  
Need band students to sign up to practice with elementary students. Scheduled for October thru November. \$50 for 5 sessions, probably on Mondays, with 30 minute time slots. Enlisting the band directors at all elementary schools. Nancy will distribute a flyer (which is being printed by Teri Gregg).
- **Central Market Halloween Party** (Nancy)  
Central Market will pay us \$1000 for 25 students (in costume) to help run their Halloween Party stations (inflatables, food, etc). They are looking for volunteers that are good with kids, enthusiastic, and are responsible. They have guidelines that each student will have to follow (e.g., no cellphones while working). Will put the Central Market guidelines on the DD website.
- **Barnes & Noble giftwrapping** (Nancy)  
At Northgate on the second or third Saturday in December. Students will wrap gifts for customers and have donation buckets out. Will also hand out coupons from the store which will also get us a portion of the sales that day. We think we can email the coupon. They would love to have some choir and band people to draw in customers. Vote taken and approved as a Funds B/C event.
- **T-shirts** (Barb)  
The dark green shirts are being made. We will sell them for \$5 each - should raise \$500. We have advertising to cover the majority of the cost.
- **Rummage Sale 9/24** (Cheryl, Kendahl)  
Posted on craigslist and put up sign in front of theater. Have been passing out small flyers. Musicians to play at 145<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> to bring in the traffic. More volunteer slots are available. Potentially more cashiers needed. They will take furniture if you can get it in the building. Price your items with the exception of books and CD's as these are a set price. Make sure you sign in at

the cafeteria before you go to your other jobs so you get credit for working. Must have a release form signed by a parent before you can work.

- **Raffle** (Denise)  
152 tickets have been sold so far. Will be at Open House and all Friday night football games until the drawing on October 27<sup>th</sup> at the band concert.
- **Next car wash** 10/2  
Wendy Bagnato agreed to run the event. Sunday, October 2 from 10-4 at the Whole Foods in Roosevelt Square. Sue Gunderson in charge of setting up sign-ups on volunteerspot.com.
- **California Pizza Kitchen** 10/10 (Michelle H.)  
Monday, October 10<sup>th</sup> at Northgate. We need to hand out flyer. Diners must present the flyer for us to get credit. This is all day so lunch and dinner. Can we hand out flyers throughout the mall?
- **Irish Happy Hour** 11/19 (Kim Strand & Denise Parker)  
This is a private event being put on by Kim Strand and Denise Parker, who are not participating in DD. Cocktail party on November 19<sup>th</sup>, \$50 per person with a small silent auction. *All* proceeds go to DD. All auction items, food and beverages are being donated by the two families. There is a limit of people. Invitation going out soon. They would like a piper to play briefly and have two flaggers greet the guests in the driveway.
- **See's Candy** (Nancy M.)  
We are scheduled to sell at the Edmonds Ferry dock Saturday and Sunday after Thanksgiving. Considering scheduling a weekend at Top Foods and Thriftway in October. It was agreed that Top was a better venue because there was cover and you face folks as they came out of the store.
- **PartyLite Candles** (Michelle D.)  
Starts October 20<sup>th</sup>. Information to be distributed at the general meeting on Sept 28 in the SC library.

Approved as another online sales event (Fund C). Just like the Pampered Chef event. Folks would go online, order their items and the rep would then kick back a portion of the proceeds.
