General Meeting Notes September 28, 2011

Explanation of Sales Events (Fund A) vs. Participatory (Funds B/C) (Mary Grassley)

Fund A: Sales events. 90% of the profit received from the sale goes to the student, and 10% to Fund C. We plan to disburse Fund A funds to WCE at the end of November, before the 12/1 payment. WCE plans to send account balances to all families prior to the 12/1 payment.

Fund B: Participatory events (events that require students to sign in for hours) . 50% of the profits from these events go into this fund. Disbursements from this fund are proportional to the number of hours a student has accumulated. Students must have a minimum of 12 hours to receive any money from this fund.

Fund C: Fund for general donations. 50% of the profits from participatory events go into this fund. Profits from events not directly associated with an hourly effort (e.g. LF Bar & Grill night) go into this fund. Disbursements from this fund are evenly distributed to all students with a minimum of 12 hours.

Treasurer Report (Peter Hughes)

Have raised approximately \$23,000 so far (includes See's Candy inventory we have not sold yet). We are at 90% of the total Dublin Dollars made four years ago.

Hours Report (Barb Swan)

74 students have met their 12 hour minimum. Family and friends can contribute a *combined* total of 12 hours to a student's total hours. Students can work as many hours as they want (don't have to stop at 12). Anyone wanting to check on their total hours can contact Barb at barbswmo2@comcast.net.
